The text article must be submitted in hard-copy, 1.5 lines spacing, on numbered pages and accompanied by a completed and signed entry form. Multimedia (photos, video and/or audio) should be submitted on a USB or CD attached to the entry form.

Four finalists will be shortlisted.

9. Finalists will be notified by email by at the completion of judging.
10. All finalists will attend a presentation function in Brisbane.
